 - b. Select "Network and Internet"
 - c. Select "Internet Options"
 - d. Select the Security tab.
 - e. Select Trusted sites and click the Sites button.
 - f. Add the URL: <u>https://*.wisconsin.gov</u>
 - g. Save the addition to the site.

- 1. Open Microsoft Edge on Windows 10
- 2. Click the ellipsis (three dots) in the top right corner for "Settings and More"
- 3. Click "Settings"
- 4. Click on Default Browser on the left pane
- 5. With the Add button, add these 3 pages from the "Internet Explorer mode pages:"
