	a.	Do you have a bank account? If so, do you know how to use the account to save money and pay bills?	
	b.	Do you know how to use a debit card issued by the bank?	
	C.	Do you know about a bank's overdraft fees? Do you know how to avoid these fees?	
	d.	Do you know how to protect yourself when using online banking? (Do you use an "App" to pay bills?)
