Anticipated Proceedings for Exit from the Settlement Agreement
(subject to further direction from the Court)

- The parties' Joint Motion to Terminate Settlement Agreement and Consent Decree on Basis of Substantial Compliance (the "Joint Motion") and supporting documents were filed on February 3, 2021.
- Copies of the Joint Motion and key documents are posted on the DCF website.
 - Additional documents will be added to the DCF website as the exit proceedings progress.
 - These documents may be viewed at <https://dcf.wisconsin.gov/mcps/settlement>.
- The case has been assigned to Judge Pamela Pepper, who is the chief judge of the federal district court located in Milwaukee.
- Judge Pepper will hold a scheduling conference with the attorneys for the parties, to determine the specific proceedings that will occur and the timetable.
- A Notice explaining the Joint Motion and further proceedings will be prepared in English and Spanish.
 - The Notice will be published in certain newspapers.
 - The Notice also will be sent to other media sources, system partners, organizations, and the lists of persons who receive Partnership Council meeting notifications and materials.
- Interested persons will have an opportunity to submit written comments to Judge Pepper. Instructions will be included in the Notice.
- The parties may file additional materials.
- Judge Pepper will hold a hearing to consider the Joint Motion.
- The parties will make presentations at the hearing.
- Other persons also may ask to be heard at the hearing. Instructions will be included in the Notice.
- Judge Pepper will issue an order deciding the Joint Motion.
