

Programs Offered by the Alma Center

We provide trauma-focused domestic violence education services for men through these programs, all of which have a foundation of healing-focused care:

Men Ending Violence (MEV) Batterers Intervention Program

2-hour classes, twice a week for 25 weeks

Restorative Fatherhood (RF) Education

• 1-hour classes, once a week for 16 weeks

<u>Wisdom Walk to Self-Mastery</u> (WW), which is an intensive program specifically designed for working with DV offenders who have extensive background trauma (e.g. violence/abuse/neglect in the home, witnessing DV in family of origin, community violence exposure) and significant ongoing effects of the trauma

• 2-hour sessions twice a week for 25 weeks).

Clients can be referred for a specific program and we will recommend a specific program as we see a need.

- Classes held 2 times per week are on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.
- Classes held 1 time per week are on Wednesday or Thursday.
- Classes are held throughout the day; morning classes that start at 8:00 am and evening classes that start at 6:30 pm

Referral Process

Intakes also can be scheduled by client or referral source calling 414-265-0100, ext. 0.
A 2-hour remote intake appointment via Zoom will be scheduled prior to program enrollment. Typically, an intake appointment can be scheduled within 5-7 days after receiving the referral, and program enrollment within 2-3 weeks after initial referral.
