**RE: Foster Care Health Screens for Children Placed Outside of the Six Pilot
Counties**

This memo is to inform all staff that when a child is placed in a county not participating in Care4Kids, the two-day timeframe for the Foster Care Health Screen is not applicable. The local Child Advocacy Center will make every effort for the child to complete a Foster Care Health Screen within five days. BMCW and Contracted Agencies staff must document in eWISACWIS the reason (i.e. placed outside of the six pilot counties) the child was not seen within in the specific timeframes.

Children placed outside of Milwaukee and in one of the five pilot counties (e.g. Ozaukee, Racine, Kenosha, Waukesha and Washington), the two-day timeframe is still applicable for the Foster Care Health Screen.
