

Subsidized Guardianship Reminder Notice

CHANGES TO BE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY BY THE LEGAL GUARDIAN(S)

- Address changes
 - 1. You will not receive your check unless we are notified.
 - 2. If you move to another state, your medical assistance will not be transferred unless you notify the Subsidized Guardianship Program.
- Death of child or legal guardian parent(s)
- Child is no longer living with you
- Children age 18 or older are not attending high school full-time or graduated
- Private health insurance coverage starts or ends
- You are not supporting child
- Termination of your subsidized guardianship
- Child has a new legal guardian(s)
- Child enters military service
- Marriage of child
