

How to Access Forms for Child Welfare Facilities

All forms for child welfare facilities, which include Residential Care Centers for Children and Youth (DCF 52), Child Placing Agencies (DCF 54), Group Homes (DCF 57) and Shelter Care Facilities (DCF 59) can be accessed through the child welfare licensing section website. There are some forms that are required to be used by facilities to be in compliance with the licensing administrative rules. Other forms, while not required by the licensing administrative rules, are recommended for use by the facilities. All licensing forms may be reproduced as needed. If you have any questions or concerns in regards to use of the forms, please contact your licensing specialist.
