Who can earn a YoungStar rating? All Wisconsin child care providers who serve children from birth through their school years can participate, as long as they're in good standing with state regulations. (Programs that have had their license or certification revoked, denied or suspended are rated 1 Star.) In fact, providers who receive a Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy must participate. When you do, you'll gain access to training opportunities, technical assistance, even micro-grants to fund books and learning materials.

YoungStar is designed to help providers improve and succeed. Our 40-point evaluation helps programs like yours recognize their strengths and identify areas for improvement. While YoungStar training programs, tips and resources give providers the tools to achieve real progress.



See your excellence recognized.

YoungStar's rating system gives providers a simple, objective measure of their program's quality. Thousands of Wisconsin child care providers are evaluated each year, in every corner of the state. Each one receives a quality rating—from 1 Star (the lowest) to 5 Stars (the highest)—based on the points they earn across four key categories:

The Provider's Education & Training

The Learning Environment & Curriculum

The Program's Professional & Business Practices

The Children's Health & Well-being

Earn ratings annually, easily.

YoungStar ratings are renewed every year, so you can earn more stars as the quality of care you provide improves.

Most ratings are awarded after an on-site review with YoungStar staff. But you may opt for an automatically-generated rating based on standards you've already met. These include minimum state-mandated health and safety requirements, accreditations or performance standards, like those required of Head Start program participants.

Reach for the stars.

You don't have to do it on your own. At youngstar.wi.gov, providers can find training opportunities, read provider success stories, and access resources to help them achieve their goals. Gaining accreditation is another way to earn a higher star level. **Here are some other tips to help you get the highest possible rating**—and give Wisconsin's children the best possible start:

Review Your Registry Program Profile

Remember to maintain your Registry Program Profile. Enter your staff's latest education and training information, assign a Lead Teacher to each classroom, and keep this information updated.

Create a Quality Improvement Plan

Assess your program's strengths and identify areas for improvement. YoungStar staff can help you set goals and timelines, assign responsibilities, and decide how to measure your progress.
