## Child Care Provider Portal Fact Sheet for Out-of-State Child Care Programs

The **Child Care Provider Portal (CCPP)** allows you to view Wisconsin Shares information online. The Provider Portal is available 24/7, and you can access it from any computer, tablet, or smartphone with an internet connection. You will be able to do the following:

- View the list of children authorized by the Wisconsin Shares subsidy program to attend your center.
- View Wisconsin Shares payments made by families using the MyWIChildCare EBT card.
- View and update your child care prices (licensed centers and programs operated by public schools).
- Send a request to end a Wisconsin Shares authorization for a child who is no longer attending or has never attended.
- Receive Wisconsin Shares notices and other communications from the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families (DCF).
- Send messages to and receive messages from your Wisconsin local child care worker.
