JAL is a **no interest loan** up to \$1,600 to help you get or keep a job.

There is **no** credit check or bank with a JAL. It can be paid back with both community service and cash over 12 months.

You may qualify if you:

- Have a job or are looking for work;
- Are older than 18;
- Have at least one minor child; and
- Have limited income.
