

Family Foundations Home Visiting (FFHV) Program

The Department of Children and Families (DCF) contracts with agencies for the Family Foundations Home Visiting (FFHV) Program. The FFHV program supports implementation of evidence-based home visiting services. FFHV is a voluntary program that enrolls families as early as pregnancy and can continue throughout the early childhood years. Services include, but are not limited to:

1. Prenatal care access;
2. Screenings & Assessments of parent and child health and well-being;
3. Health education;
4. Parent-child relationships;
5. Child development/age-appropriate expectations; and
6. Connections to community resources.

Consistent with state procurement requirements, DCF will conduct a competitive procurement process for the selection of contract recipients.
