Introduction

The Parent/Caregiver Advisory Cabinet (PCAC) was established in 2022 to ensure the state's early childhood programs, policies, and services reflect the needs of children ages 0-8 and that the lived expertise of parents and caregivers inform agency priorities and decisions.

This report provides a summary of accomplishments from the cabinet in 2024 and outlines the goals and activities established for 2025.

2024 Accomplishments

In 2024, the seven members of the PCAC supported the following accomplishments:

- Created and distributed a survey with 115 parent responses across the state to better understand how they would like to define quality in YoungStar
- Hosted three community conversations to gather feedback from parents to guide the revision of YoungStar
- Advised DCF in revising the Child Care Finder's capabilities
- Held monthly co-planning meetings to support planning and develop agendas for meetings with DCF
- Implemented three workgroups to ensure progress in achieving 2024 goals
- 6 Supported local child care efforts in communities
- Had 100% attendance at every meeting
- Informed the agency-wide lived experience framework and ways of working
- Co-designed individual <u>Parent Portraits</u> to build awareness and connections to the Cabinet
