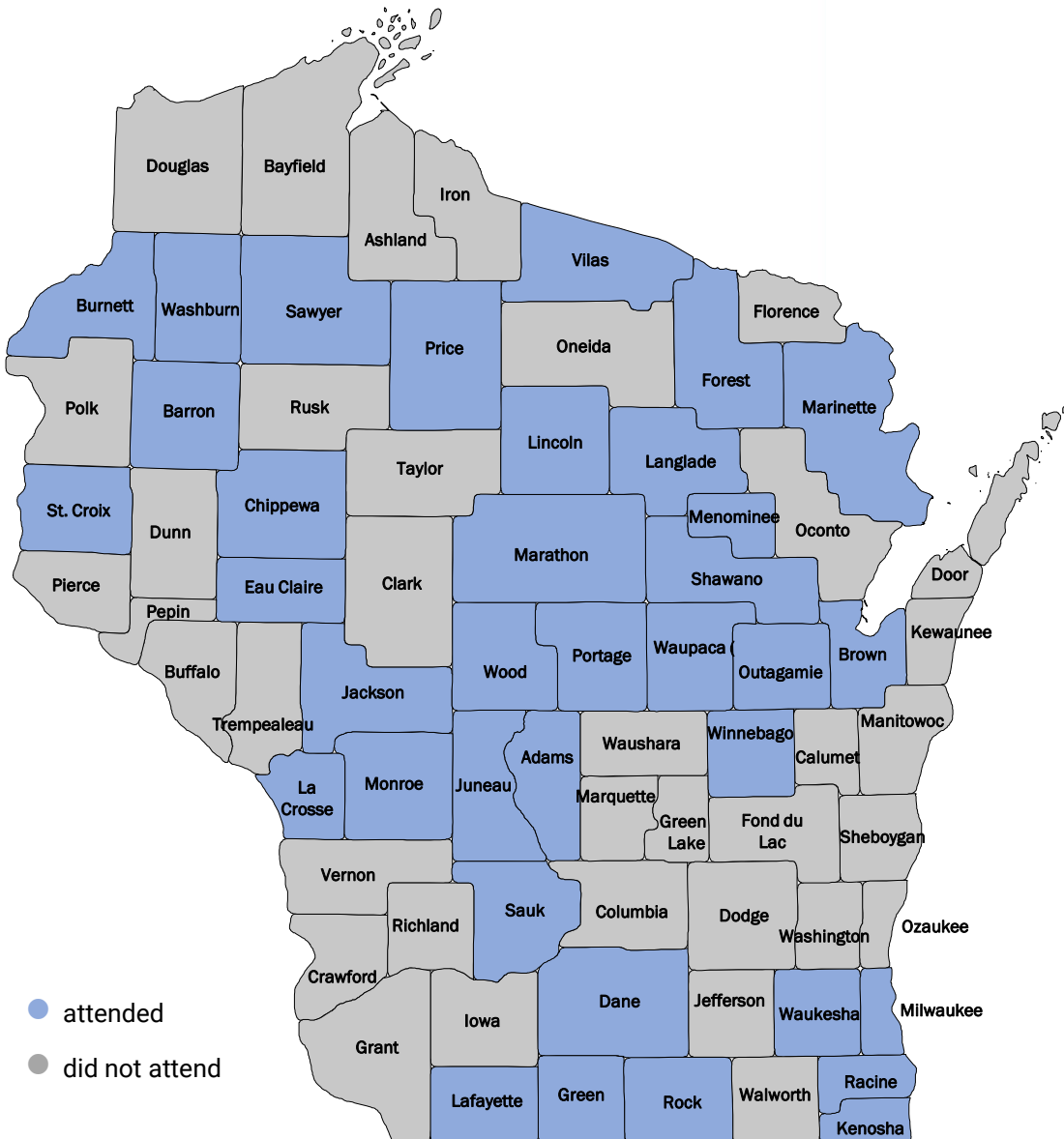


# WICWA Training Map
