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# BWF Updates – Mac Strawder, Linda Richardson, Debra Cronmiller, and Ed Emmons

- Monitoring information sessions were received positively.
  - o An FAQ document will be compiled by the end of August.
- Agencies received an email regarding the Program Integrity Roundtable to be held on Sept. 17.
  - Agency staff should bring cases, questions, etc.
- Child Support Liaisons (CSLs) are needed for the DFES Division-Wide Event in April 2020.
- The WCSA Conference will be held Sept. 18-20.
  - Agency staff are encouraged to attend, especially CSLs.
- A domestic violence course organized by the federal government may be useful to CSLs.
- Work has begun on 2020 contracts.
- The Work Programs Conference will be held on October 28-29.
  - o Eventbrite invitations will be sent next week (can be forwarded to others).
- In the Child Care demonstration project, participants with more money:
  - o Chose higher-rated providers;
  - o Spent more hours per week in W-2 activities;
  - o Found jobs faster; and

### Automation Updates - Jane Kahl

- A new functionality in CWW allows targeted mass mailings.
- A new functionality is being planned in ACCESS to allow individuals to start a W-2 application online and schedule an in-person appointment to complete the application.
- New electronic signature functionality will be used for Employment Plans in WWP and other required W-2 documents.
  - o Signed copies will automatically be stored in ECF.
  - o The participant will be able to view the documents in ACCESS.
- Heavily used BI screens will be moved into CWW.
- A biometric authentication has successfully been added to MyACCESS.
