## Welcome and Introductions - Debra Cronmiller

- Budget Initiatives
  - Drug testing and Child-only payments
  - o Case Management Follow-up Payments
  - o Expanding TJ services to four additional counties
  - o JAL enhancements
- Recent and ongoing BWF recruitments
  - o Program Integrity and Performance Contract Specialist
  - Milwaukee Operations OPA and HSAC
  - Policy and Automation Two PPA positions
    - Liz Riley has accepted another position in DCF.

#### **Contract Issues –Linda Richardson**

- Reminder: Use new codes to report capitation expenditures for ISS funding.
- Linda Richardson recently attended the TANF Summit in Washington, DC.
  - Other states are dealing with similar issues to WI.
  - The federal government will focus on harder to serve populations.
  - Example of a useful resource: <u>www.newhavenmomspartnership.org</u>
- 2018 contract discussions are in progress.
  - Contracts will contain new civil rights language.
  - BWF is waiting on finalization of proposed 2018 performance outcomes.

## **Federal Compliance – Ed Emmons**

- Federal reporting changes will affect WPR.
- Recent data load issues
  - July preliminary WPR contains fewer W-2 T cases in the denominator.
    - Some W-2 Ts have been moved to child-only cases.
  - The federal reporting week now corresponds with the activity week.
- The federal reporting system will gradually be moved to a newer programming language.
- Agencies should provide the names of staff to be notified in case of data load issues.
  - Sara Baudhuin will solicit this information via email.
  - o BWF will create a dedicated email distribution list.

# **Policy Changes – Debra Cronmiller**

- Recently published items
  - Ops Memos 17-15, 17-16, and 17-17 Time Limits
  - Ops Memo 17-18 BRITS enhancements based on user feedback
- Forthcoming items
  - Updated Ops Memo on vocational education tracking.
    - Instructions on the use of proper closure codes.
    - Preventing inappropriately earned payments.
  - Updates to BI guide and TMJ/TJ manual
  - o Joint Ops Memo with Child Care regarding the counting of subsidized wages

## Automation Updates – Danise Doudna, Heidi Hammes, and Ginger Seery

- Time Limits
  - Phase 1 was implemented in August 2017.
  - Phase 2 will be implemented in October 2018 (notices and move to 48 Month lifetime state limit).
- WPASS
  - o See PowerPoint Presentation <u>WPASS Phased Implementation Overview</u>
  - WPASS demo will be shown at the Work Programs Conference in October 2017.
- BRITS see <u>handout</u>
- HOD print functionality will no longer be supported in 2019.
  - Replacement needs to be in place by Fall 2018.
- DHS will be moving all notices from the mainframe to CWW.
  - W-2 notices will no longer be translated into Hmong.
  - BWF will consider other languages for translation if criteria are met.
