<u>Governor Evers announced</u> a new <u>Recovery Voucher Program</u> in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) and the Wisconsin Department of Administration.

This program is available to individuals experiencing category 1, 2, or 4 homelessness and who also have an opioid use disorder (OUD) diagnosis or have received treatment for OUD within the past 12 months. Individuals meeting the criteria are eligible to be housed in a DHS recognized recovery residence, which are located throughout the state.

DHS has more information on the categories of homelessness.
