PURPOSE

The purpose of this memo is to notify Transform Milwaukee Jobs (TMJ) Contractors of a modification to CARES screen CRTM (Transform Milwaukee Jobs Eligibility Determination). This memo also informs Contractors to remind parents in TMJ, who have a court order for support, of the child support notice requirements.

BACKGROUND

The TMJ program is a subsidized employment program designed to assist low-income adults in Milwaukee County transition into stable unsubsidized employment. The Bureau of Working Families (BWF) is collecting eligibility information that it will use in conducting evaluations of the program in the future.

Under Wisconsin Statute, parents who have a court order for support are required to notify the child support agency of any changes in income or employment within ten business days. Subsidized employment earnings under TMJ are subject to all child support collections efforts.

CARES

To support evaluation of the TMJ program, BWF has added a new field to CRTM. Contractors must enter a **Y** or **N** in the NON CUSTODIAL PARENT field in order to complete eligibility determination.

The NON CUSTODIAL PARENT field will display as blank for all TMJ eligibility determinations that were entered into CARES prior to the modification to CRTM.

AGENCY ACTION

With the modification to CRTM, Contractors must add an NCP column to their manual TMJ tracking sheets and indicate the noncustodial parent status of all TMJ eligibility determinations that they have entered into CARES through July 18, 2014. Contractors do not need to indicate the NCP status for TMJ participants added to the tracking sheet after July 18, 2014, since the contractor is now required to enter that information into CARES. At a later date, BWF will use this tracking sheet to enter NCP status information for TMJ participants added to the tracking sheet through July 6, 2014.

Contractors must also remind parents in TMJ, who have a court order for support, that they are required under state law to notify the child support agency immediately upon securing employment.
