PURPOSE

The purpose of this memo is to communicate a change to the Job Access Loan (JAL) Combined Application and Repayment Agreement form.

BACKGROUND

In most cases, JALs cannot be written-off in bankruptcy proceedings because the loans are typically regarded as a domestic support obligation, as defined in 11 U.S.C. § 101(14A). The State of Wisconsin Department of Justice has advised the Bureau of Working Families (BWF) to incorporate language in the JAL Combined Application and Repayment Agreement (JAL application) that explicitly states that the borrower acknowledges that the JAL is a domestic support obligation. The inclusion of such language on the JAL application may curb future challenges to claims in bankruptcy proceedings about the nature of the support provided to JAL recipients.

FORM CHANGE

The W-2 agencies must continue to use the <u>JAL Combined Application and Repayment Agreement form (2482)</u>. The form has been revised to include the following under the Acknowledgement of Receipt of Job Access Loan and Terms of Repayment section:

I acknowledge that this loan is intended to support my child or children and my family by helping me to get employment that will raise my family's income.

JAL applicants must check that they understand the intent of the support when completing the form, along with the other JAL loan receipt acknowledgements and terms of repayments.

There are no changes to W-2 policy.

AGENCY ACTION

W-2 agencies must familiarize staff with the change to the JAL application form so that they are prepared to assist W-2 applicants and participants in completing the form. W-2 agencies and workers shall use the revised <u>JAL Combined Application and Repayment Agreement form (2482) (R. 12/2015)</u> beginning immediately.
