

Notice of Refusal to Participate Wisconsin Works

You or an adult in your Wisconsin Works (W-2) group refused to participate in W-2. A refusal to participate means you did not follow the work rules of the W-2 program and are not eligible to participate in W-2 for 90 days.

Refusal to Participate Reason:

You have until [MM/DD/YYYY] to provide additional information to your worker about why you or an adult in your W-2 group refused to participate. Your W-2 agency will decide whether this additional information will change your eligibility to participate in the W-2 program.

If your worker does not hear from you or you do not give your worker information to change your eligibility, you will be ineligible to participate in the W-2 program for 90 days beginning on [MM/DD/YYYY]. You may be eligible to participate in the W-2 program again after [MM/DD/YYYY]. You must reapply for W-2 to determine if you are eligible.

If you have questions, contact your W-2 worker listed above.

DO YOU NEED AN ACCOMMODATION?

If something might keep you from doing your W-2 activities, please tell your W-2 worker right away. If you need an accommodation to do your W-2 activities, please ask your worker shown on page one of this notice. You may also want to tell your worker about any domestic violence now or in the past.

If you aren't sure of you need an accommodation, you may ask your worker to help you complete the Barrier Screening Tool (BST). You may also ask your worker to help find a doctor who can help explain what might be stopping you from doing your W-2 activities. The BST and doctor reports will give your worker more information about or work site accommodations you may need.
