2.1.1 TMJ GENERAL POPULATION

For the TMJ general population, individuals who meet the eligibility criteria in 2.1 must be a current resident of Milwaukee <u>County</u>. and reside within the following boundaries of the <u>TMJ service area</u>:

North – West Silver Spring
Drive South – West Mitchell
Street
West – North Sherman
Boulevard East – Highway 43

In addition, individuals must be 18 years of age or older and:

- 1. Be a parent with a child support order and required to pay child support;
- 2. Be a parent under a reunification plan;
- 3. Be a parent who is an ex- offender; or
- 4. Be between 18 to 24 years of age with no children (childless young adult).

Contractors must develop mechanisms to verify an <u>applicant resides within Milwaukee</u> <u>County.</u> applicant's residency status with respect to the service area boundaries. Up to twenty (20) percent of the general population enrolled in TMJ may reside within one (1) mile outside of the target area boundaries.
