

Wisconsin Works Placement Notice

Congratulations on your job! Because you have found a job, you have been placed in the Case Management – Follow Up Plus (CMF+) placement. This decision was based on the information you and your W-2 worker discussed during your assessment. In this placement, you may get case management services. This placement began on <date>.

You are no longer eligible for a Community Service Job (CSJ) or W-2 Transition (W-2T) payment. You may be eligible for a CMF+ payment while working. The CMF+ payment is \$50 per month. You must be in this placement for a full participation period from the 16th of the current month to the 15th of the next month to receive a payment. You may receive a CMF+ payment for up to 12 months if you continue to be eligible. You must report changes affecting your eligibility within 10 days. Receiving a CMF+ payment will not count towards your W-2 time limit. You will receive all child support collected by the state.

You can continue to get W-2 services. These case management follow-up services may help you:

- Solve child care or transportation problems;
- Solve problems that may come up in your job;
- Find education and training classes;
- Apply for the Earned Income Tax Credit and create a household budget;
- Get a better job.

W-2 Payment Information

W-2 CMF+ Payments

You will receive a \$50 CMF+ payment each month that you are in a CMF+ placement from the 16th of a month through the 15th of the next month. This payment is not reduced for any reason. If your CMF+ placement ends before the 15th of the month, you will not receive a \$50 CMF+ payment.

How You Will Get Your Payments

W-2 Final CSJ or W-2 T Payments

You will get your final CSJ or W-2 T payment on or around <final payment date>. You can view your W-2 placement and payment information in ACCESS. Visit <https://access.wisconsin.gov>

Payment Reductions

Your CSJ or W-2 T payment may be reduced for the following reasons:

1. \$5.00 for each missed hour of assigned activity without good cause;
2. A Learnfare penalty of \$50 each month for each child who has a Learnfare sanction;
3. A penalty of up to 15% if an adult in the W-2 group is a convicted drug felon;
4. For a W-2 or AFDC overpayment in the past.

You will receive a Payment Statement if your payment is reduced for any of these reasons.
