17.3.2 Prohibited Uses of JAL Funds

Unacceptable uses of JAL funds include:

- Alleviating a financial crisis that is the result of the individual's failure to accept a bona fide offer of employment or the individual's termination of a job without good cause (See <u>11.3.1</u>);
- Paying any fine related to operating a motor vehicle under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol, including but not limited to, fines for Operating While Impaired, Blood Alcohol Content, and Implied Consent Violations;
- Covering expenses that are or could be covered by the <u>EA</u> program;
- Purchasing luxury items that are not necessary for work performance and maintenance; or
- Paying taxes.

W-2 agencies should inform applicants of resources and programs that may be able to alleviate their financial crisis without needing to be repaid.
