Report Title: Employment Report 03: Employments and Potential POP Claims

Location: DCF/Wisdom/Employment Programs/W-2 Case Management/Employment Reports

Background: This report attempts to address some of the gaps of Employment Report 01, and provide more data for POP Claim decision making. This report utilizes some of the new Employment data from WWP, merging it with current POP Claim data. The data updates daily to allow for timely decision-making.

Purpose: The primary purpose of the report is to list employments that have start dates in a specified range of months. Additional tabs show employments that meet a number of POP Claim criteria for participants who have not had a Job Attainment or Job Retention claim initiated within a calendar year. Research still needs to be done by the Agency to ensure the employment meets the criteria for a POP Claim.

Description of Report: This report lists employments and associated data, to include information about associated POP Claims for the employment and recent POP claims for the participant.

This report attempts to close the gap between employment reporting and potential POP claims by filtering the data on specific tabs to only those participants and employments that meet a series of data requirements.

For example, there is a tab that lists all of the employments specified by the report prompts that satisfy the following criteria:

- The employment lasted 31 or more days, based on employment begin and end dates
- There is no JA associated with this employment
- There has not been a JA initiated for the participant in the past year
- The participant was in a placement one day prior to the employment begin date

Another tab lists all of the employments specified by the report prompts that satisfy the following criteria:

- The employment lasted 93 or more days, based on employment begin and end dates
- There is no JR associated with this employment
- There has not been a JR initiated for the participant in the past year
- The participant was in a placement one day prior to the employment begin date

Research still needs to be done by the Agency to ensure the employment meets the criteria for a POP Claim.
