

The Benefit Recovery Investigation Tracking System (BRITS) will be updated on May 27, 2025. These changes will be available for users on May 28, 2025. Here is what you need to know.

## BRITS Enhancements

### JAL

1. Approved JALs now appear on the Workload list in the JAL Applications section for JAL Creators, making the total workload more comprehensive for the user.

2. The Monthly Budget Section now includes a Savings and a Prospective Income field to better calculate an individual's ability to repay the loan and to adhere more closely to W-2 Policy 17.2.3.

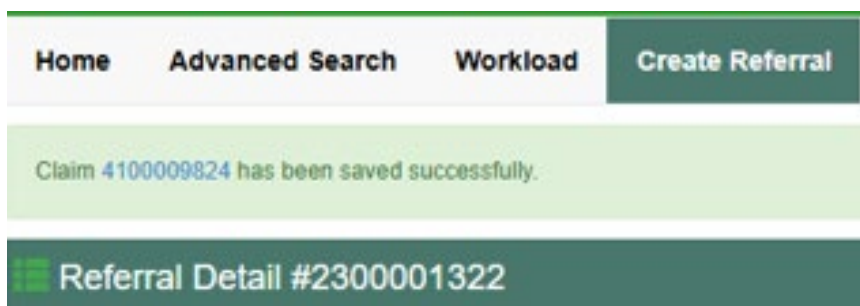

3. The Monthly Budget section now requires a positive Net Monthly Income to demonstrate that the individual is able to repay the loan before the loan can be sent for Approval.



### W-2 Overpayments

1. After creating an overpayment claim from a referral, the banner indicating that a claim was created and link to the claim will display for a longer timeframe.



### BRITS Reporting

1. JAL Spending Target Report now includes JALs by their Approval Date, and added claim detail can be seen on the Detail Report Tab.
