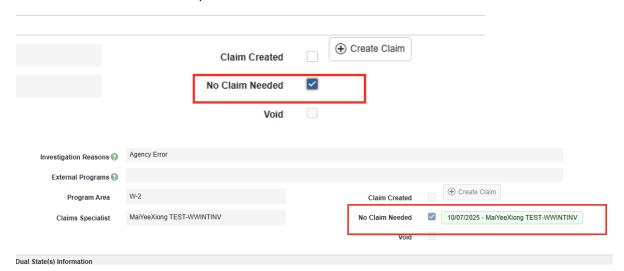
The Benefit Recovery Investigation Tracking System (BRITS) was updated on October 15, 2025. These changes will be available for users on October 16, 2025. Additionally changes to CWW notices will be in production on October 18, 2025. Here is what you need to know.

# **BRITS and CWW System Updates**

## **BRITS Enhancements**

#### **JAL**

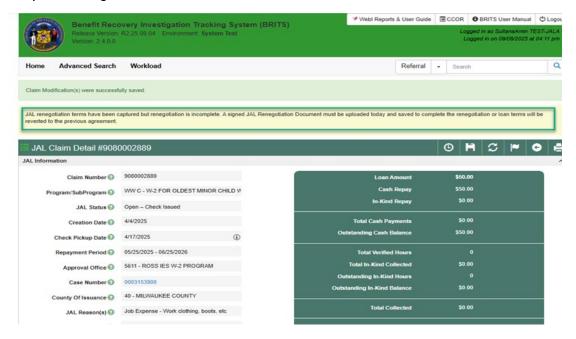
1. When a worker processes a claim and has a referral type as "Agency Error Claim", a worker will now be able to select no claim is needed so that they can close the referral without needing to take action that inaccurately reflects the outcome of the referral (i.e. void it or create a 'fake' claim).



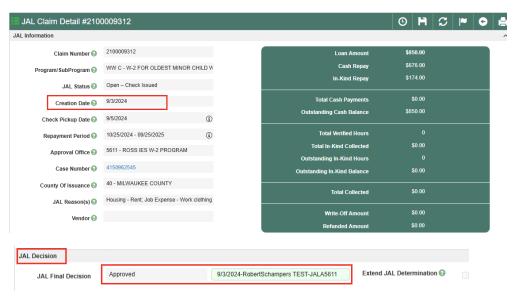
2. On the Home Page Recent Activity grid, liable person(s) has been added the column labeled, Primary. It will now read as "Primary/Liable Person(s)", to provide an accurate view of all participants who is liable for the claim, not just the primary person on the case.



3. When a JAL is renegotiated, but there is no renegotiated document added, the JAL will discard the renegotiation and revert to the original terms. There will now be an error message that will display to the worker, "JAL renegotiation terms have been captured but renegotiation is incomplete. A signed JAL Renegotiation Document must be uploaded today and saved to complete the renegotiation or loan terms will be reverted to the previous agreement."



4. Currently on a JAL detail claims page, after a claim has been approved, the approval date appears as the check pickup date and the JAL decision section disappears. With the enhancement, workers will now see the approved date as the date the claim was approved in the JAL decision section and the JAL decision section will remain on the page.



## W-2 Overpayments

When a worker processes a W-2 overpayment claim, there will now be a new option to select for overpayment reason for "Missed Hours Not Deducted". The new reason code has also been added to the notices that is generated to the participant in English, Spanish and Hmong.

#### PDF Tool Validation (New information added on 10/23/25)

To successfully generate and print overpayment notices through BRITS, the formatting of the overpayment worksheet must meet specific criteria, including (but not limited to):

- Left and right-side margin sizing (Left:0.8", Right: 0.38")
- Page size (8.5" x 11")
- Orientation (Portrait)

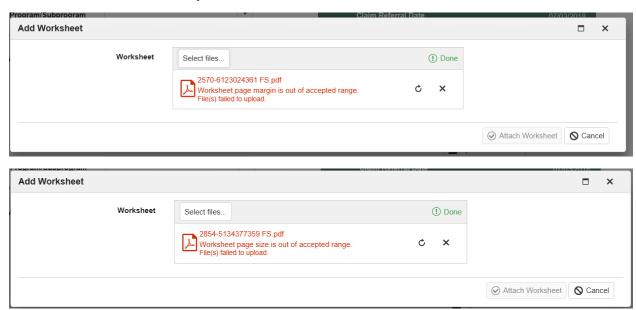
## What's Changing?

Effective **10/24/2025** when a worksheet is uploaded BRITS will check for appropriate margin and page sizing. A success or failure message will display in the Add Worksheet Popup box.

• If accepted, you will see the Files(s) uploaded successfully message.



• If **rejected**, BRITS will display the File(s) failed to upload messaging with the reason why it failed.



Users must continue to utilize the program area approved worksheet; this change will simply notify you if it doesn't meet these criteria.
