A new report called **Cap Report 01a: W-2 Capitated Payments Detail by Contract Agency for the Month CMC Placement** has been published to the DCF/WISDOM/Employment Programs/Wisconsin Works/ W-2 Capitated Payment folder in WEbl.

**Background:** This report was created during the implementation of the MPOWR project. This report looks at the CMC placements that will be automatically closed after 56 days.

**Purpose:** This report will show agency staff the individuals on the CMC placement whose cases will be automatically closed by the new MPOWR Process (See Memo) because they are meeting the 56 days limit for that placement.

**Description of Report:** This report shows the detail and summary information for each contract agency regarding CMC placed individuals who are scheduled to be close automatically by the CARES system due to the 56 day time limit. This report will also show if any of these CMC placements were backdated and if the closure of these cases will affect the capitated payments for that case that are paid out to the W-2 agencies.

**Prompts:** Select the Report Month and then select either WP Contract Agency or WP County/Tribe. You can look at the cases scheduled for closure by County, Agency, or Office Number.

A new report called **Cap Report 01b: W-2 Placement Closed by Batch for Lack of W-2 Eligibility for the Month** has been published to the DCF/WISDOM/Employment Programs/ Wisconsin Works/ W-2 Capitated Payment folder in WEbl.

**Background:** This report was created during the implementation of the MPOWR project. This report shows the W-2 placements that will be automatically closed due to lack of financial or non-financial eligibility. This includes cases that have not been reviewed within the last six months and/or have an expired Employability Plan (EP).

**Purpose:** The purpose of this report is to inform the W-2 agencies of the cases that will be automatically closed by the CARES system for lack of eligibility, review, or have an expired Employability Plan.

**Description of Report:** This report shows the detail and summary information for each contract agency regarding individuals who are scheduled to be close automatically by the CARES system due to lack of W-2 eligibility or an expired Employability Plan. This report will also show if any of

these cases were backdated and if the closure of these cases will affect the capitated payments for that case that are paid out to the W-2 agencies.

**Prompts:** Select the Report Month and then select either WP Contract Agency or WP County/Tribe. You can look at the cases scheduled for closure by County, Agency, or Office Number.

A new report called **Cap Report 01c: W-2 Cases with Open Placement Episodes Pending for W-2 AG to be closed** has been published to the DCF/WISDOM/Employment Programs/ Wisconsin Works/ W-2 Capitated Payment folder in WEbl.

This report will also show if any of these cases were backdated and if the closure of these cases will affect the capitated payments for that case that are paid out to the W-2 agencies.
