

A new report entitled Caseload Report 05: W-2 Participant Characteristics has been created and published in WEBI to the following folder location:

This report shows various demographic characteristics of W-2 participants by month, including: gender, relationship status, participant age ranges, race/ethnicity, highest level of education achieved, number of children in the assistance group, age of the youngest child (6 and under or over 6), paid or unpaid placement status, most recent placement type, and status of having a driver's license and access to a vehicle. The report includes tabs showing these characteristics in counts and in percentages of the total caseload for Wisconsin, for Balance of State/Milwaukee County, and for W-2 agencies. This report can be used to track changes in demographic characteristics of the caseload over time, compare certain demographic features of the caseload living in Balance of State vs. Milwaukee County, or identify features of the caseload that may differ agency to agency.
