

Good Afternoon,

As some of you may have heard at the recent Systems Subcommittee meeting, Research and Statistics is initiating an effort to clean up the folders in WEBI. This initiative includes removing obsolete or broken reports, and combining duplicative reports. This will help to declutter many of the report folders and reduce confusion and maintenance overhead. This project will also have the additional benefit of making reports easier to find and less frustrating to use.

Overall, the effort will include removing the old JDPA, and other obsolete programs, reports, and combining similar reports into single, multi-tabbed reports.

For example: In the WISDOM/Employment Programs/ Work Programs folder there are individual reports that say WP Activities by Activity-Status by Month-State, WP Activities by Activity Status by Month-WDA, etc. These reports will be combined into one report that says WP Activities by Activity Status by Month with tabs for State, Agency, Office and WDA.

Combining these multiple reports into single tabbed reports may have an impact the way that you export your data to Excel or CSV's. Please be aware that any shortcuts to the reports that are ultimately removed will break, so if you encounter "report not found" types of errors, you may need to manually find the new report.

The following folders in WEBI are currently part of the WEBI clean-up project:

WISDOM/Employment Programs/ Work Programs and all subfolders

We expect this effort to continue for the next six months. We will provide further updates on this project as needed.
