

The Performance Outcome Payment reports for the W-2 T Engagement have been published in Webl. The two reports are SPARC Report 07: W-2 T Engagement Incentive Payments Summary and SPARC 07(a): W-2 T Engagement Incentive Details.

Purpose: The primary purpose of these two reports is to help the DCF Bureau of Finance disburse payments to the W-2 agencies for the W-2 T Engagement Incentive. These reports can also be used by W-2 contract agencies to forecast their payments.

Load Schedule: "Final" data for March 2018 has been loaded and is ready for users to view. April 2018 data will remain "Preliminary" until on or about the last business day in May 2018, and "Final" data for April 2018 will be available on or about the first business day in June 2018.

SPARC Report 07: W-2 T Engagement Incentive Payments Summary

This report lists the number of participants that earned each threshold level, and the amount W-2 agencies will receive for the incentive.

SPARC 07(a): W-2 T Engagement Incentive Details

This report shows participant details for the W-2 T Engagement Incentive, including case number, PIN, participant name, days in W-2 T placement, threshold level earned, total average weekly hours worked in activities eligible for an incentive, and previous W-2 T Engagement Incentives earned. This report also lists details for W-2 T participants that did not earn an incentive.

Please note, there is a tab for incentives earned in prior months called "Hours Completed Without Payment". This tab will be blank until April 2018 "Final" data posts.
