

All TMJ/TJ reports in the Employment Programs folder are once again ready for use. As mentioned in previous messages, maintenance was being performed on TMJ/TJ reports and caseload reports with activities. Additional validation was needed on the TMJ/TJ Reports 5, 6, and 11 for the NA phase. The validation on these reports is complete, and the data is once again considered reliable.

The maintenance was being performed because CARES screen WPTM (TMJ/TJ Phase Tracking) will become obsolete during the migration to WPASS. As a result, the following TMJ/TJ Reports have been updated to use the new W-2D data warehouse for phase tracking in WebI:
