- Serves as the blueprint document for the online developer.
- Enables reviewers to visualize content, interactions, and navigation before online development begins.
- Saves time and money.

- Headers/Footers
- Font sizes for titles, topic headings, body text, etc.
- Color scheme
- Navigation and Interaction buttons
- Clipart, photos, or both
- Bullet styles

### Components of a Good Storyboard

- **Text** - The text displayed on each slide, including headings
- **Narration** - The audio script
- **Media** - Graphics, Videos, Sound effects
- **Animation** - Movement, Text and graphic transitions
- **Interaction/Activities** - T/F, MC, Matching, Click Reveal, etc.
- **Navigation** - Timing, Branching
