Removing Mouse Pointer From Screenshots in Greenshot

Did you know that when you record a screenshot using Greenshot, you can decide if the mouse pointer will be included in the recording or not? Here's how:



Step 1: Open the Greenshot Preferences by right clicking the Greenshot icon in the system tray and choose "Preferences".

Step 2: On the "*Capture*" tab, remove the checkmark from the "*Capture mousepointer*" checkbox option.

Then click "OK".

If you want to include the mouse pointer again, simply put a checkmark in the checkbox again.
