YoungStar Evaluation Criteria
D.1.3

***Social/Emotional/Inclusion Training:
15 or more hours of YoungStar-approved non-credit training on inclusive practices,
serving children with disabilities, children with special health needs.***

The Registry will accept Tier 2 and Tier 3 level trainings for the YoungStar evaluation criteria D.1.3. The 15 or more hours of YoungStar-approved non-credit training on inclusive practices serving children with disabilities or children with special health needs can be recorded with the Registry but will only be transmitted over to YoungStar when the participants receives 15 or more hours of training. The sponsor of the trainings will need to make sure the trainings are entered into The Registry and that the roster of participants who have completed the trainings have been submitted to the Registry.

How does a training sponsor receive approval for non-credit training?

The approved trainer will complete and submit a training event for approval by The Registry. Course details will be provided that identify the description, goals and objectives of the specific training and will clearly identify the assessment strategy that will be used by the trainer to ensure that the training content has been delivered in a format that meets the needs of multiple learners. The core knowledge learning areas will be identified.

An intermediate or master trainer is required for Tier 2 or Tier 3 training. The trainer will need to meet the trainer education requirement including meeting the Registry Career Level identified and meet the hours requirement in the core knowledge area for which the training will be conducted. The trainer will also have to have sufficient qualifications to train in adult education and experience in early childhood training. The trainer will utilize the PDAS approval system to submit the training for approval.
