

## **TRIBES TLC Training** **Approved Courses for Registry Recognition**

### **TRIBES Training**

Research consistently demonstrates that a strong social and emotional foundation is a key determinant in a child's success. As part of YoungStar, programs that serve school-age children can receive optional points for completing training in social and emotional learning and creating a positive social context for children. For one point, 50% of Lead Teachers/Group Leaders and Director have completed a TRIBES TLC Training. For two points, 100% of the Lead Teachers/Group Leaders and Director have completed a TRIBES TLC Training. The training must be at least 12 hours in length.

YoungStar will recognize the TRIBES TLC Training course if it meets or exceeds 12 clock hours total of training. The following will be approved courses from TRIBES TLC:

- Implementing Afterschool TRIBES (12 hours)
- Building Community for Learning (TRIBES "Basic" Training) (24 hours)
- Discovering Gifts in Middle School (24 hours)
- Engaging All by Creating High School Learning Communities (24 hours)
- Artistry For Learning (24 hours)

For The Registry to recognize TRIBES TLC Training, programs can submit the following:

- Name of participant
- Last 5 digits of social security number and birth date OR
- Registry number
- School that the participant attended for the training
- Approximate dates of training

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The TRIBES TLC office will cross reference the above information with their database. Staff from the TRIBES TLC office will be able to enter the participant(s) into a TRIBES course (portal) to directly enter the individual's information into The Registry. The Registry will set up the portal and provide training to TRIBES TLC staff on how to enter the individual's completion of TRIBES TLC Training information. The Registry will then transfer the data over to the YoungStar case management.
