Social Emotional and Inclusion of Children with Special Needs Training Evaluation Criteria

The development of healthy social and emotional skills is critical to a child’s success throughout their education and into adulthood. A child’s ability to get along with others, use impulse control, identify emotions in themselves and others, follow directions, and solve problems begins at birth and continues throughout the early childhood years, when rapid brain development is occurring. Within the context of relationships with nurturing adults and peers, these skills are developed with intentional teaching of social and emotional competencies. Including children with special needs in a program’s activities and daily routines is important for the development and success of all children. Inclusion helps to create a sense of belonging, creates positive social relationships, and helps children understand how differences make each child unique and important. High-quality training focused on the use of evidence-based strategies in these two areas allows educators to enhance their practices.

VERIFICATION:
