


Narrative of Monthly Report April 2017


For the month of April, the following are notable YoungStar statistics.






★ Rating and Wisconsin Shares Data






★ Rating History and Composition:

The composition of currently rated programs is shown below for April.






The graph below shows the movement in rating type chosen by providers over the past three years.
