



## Narrative of Monthly Report March 2020

★ **Participation and Rating Composition:**




★ **Rating and Wisconsin Shares Data**





The composition of currently rated programs is shown below for March.



The graph below shows the movement in rating type chosen by providers over the past two years.





The graph below shows movement in rating levels for providers over the past year.





