


Narrative of Monthly Report March 2022


For the month of March, the following are notable YoungStar statistics.

★ Participation and Rating Composition:

We currently have 3,858 programs participating in YoungStar. This is an increase of 2 programs as compared to February. The chart and graph below show the rating composition by region for the current month.







★ Rating and Wisconsin Shares Data






Rating History and Composition:

The composition of currently rated programs is shown below for March.






The graph below shows the movement in rating type chosen by providers over the past two years.



The graph below shows movement in rating levels for providers over the past year.






High-Quality Practices:


As part of the YoungStar evaluation process, programs can be evaluated for having key high-quality practices. The number of programs with high-quality practices is shown below by region.

Onsite Services:


