Advanced Standing for Practicum 1 & 2 may be awarded for individuals with 2 years of experience. While earning 3 credit for the CPL class, students will also be able to work toward "Indep Study" portfolio documentation to demonstrate competencies for 1) Health, Safety, Nutrition, 2) Infant/Toddler Development, and/or 3) Foundations of ECE. Waukesha County Technical College	<b>Individualized, case-by-case review:</b> Practicum 1, Practicum 2 and Health, Safety & Nutrition: Students can obtain CPL credit by submitting a <b>portfolio proficiency</b> for evaluation. Minimum requirement to be eligible to complete the proficiency from Practicum are 2 years, full time lead teaching experience and the student must either have documentation of WMELS training or be willing to enroll in our 1 credit WMELS online course. In addition we will consider additional requests for other courses based on the unique work and educational history of the individual- in those cases a portfolio is required that documents knowledge, skills and dispositions aligned with course competencies.  Do not currently offer the ECE CPL class. College is developing college-wide CPL processes that will have to align with.	In 2012, 6 Students received 6 credits Enormous Growth in Degree Program.
