

Job Access Loan (JAL)



Do you need help paying for:

- **A car repair?**
- **A car loan?**
- **Car insurance?**
- **Job clothing or uniforms?**
- **Tools or supplies for work?**
- **Housing costs to get or keep a job?**
- **Fees or fines to get your driver's license?**

If you answered **yes** to any of the above, a loan with **JAL** might be right for you!

JAL is a no interest loan up to \$1,600 to help you get or keep a job.

There is no credit check or bank account with a JAL. It can be paid back with both community service and cash over 12 months.

You may qualify if you:

- Have a job or are looking for work;
- Are older than 18;
- Have at least one minor child; and
- Have limited income.
