Supporting families from pregnancy through early childhood with trusted, community-based care.

Family Foundations Home Visiting Program is a voluntary home-based program serving families in Wisconsin. The program provides personalized support during pregnancy and early childhood, helping families access resources, strengthen parenting, and supporting healthy child development.

Services are designed to meet families where they are, offering flexible, relationship-based support that builds trust and promotes long-term well-being.



Who Is Served

While all new parents and caregivers benefit from support, it is particularly essential for those who are parenting and struggling with their mental health, living in a lower income household or facing other challenges. For this reason, the FFHV Program prioritizes serving families who are facing adversity.

What Home Visitors Do

- Provide parenting support and guidance
- Connect families to health and community services
- Support child development and school readiness

Program Impact

Home visiting in Wisconsin is making a meaningful difference for families and communities. FFHV serves **2,300** families across **40 of 72** counties and **6 out of 11** federally recognized tribes.

“ The parents who were deeply impacted by their own trauma and childhood history relied on physical punishment for disciplining their children. The home visitor explored positive discipline techniques with the parents. Both parents recognized that they were acting out of habit rather than love, and that their parenting philosophy needed to change to align with the nurturing environment they wanted to create. "We realized we won't be doing that anymore," they told her home visitor. By shifting away from physical punishment, this family is actively rewriting their family story, breaking the cycle of trauma, and choosing a path of love and self-regulation.
